According to national statistics, today more than half of those who are homeless are women and children fleeing domestic violence. "When breaking free from their abusive relationships, South Asian women have little established community support system to which they could turn. They also lack resources and information about mainstream service providers who could help them with alternatives to their abusive situations," said Maliha Imami-Alam, Community

Development Coordinator. "We have a clear problem that is in dire need of a solution. Daya's "Transitional Housing" program will be a significant step towards being a part of the solution." On March 10, 2007 Daya will be organizing its Annual Fundraiser 'New Beginnings' at the Stafford Civic Center (old) with the focus of raising funds for the proposed 'Transitional Housing' facility.
