In 2023, Daya served 619 survivors of Domestic and Sexual Violence, with compassionate and culturally responsive services, during some of the most challenging times in their life.

### Voices Heard, Lives Changed

Daya's licensed therapists provided 428 sessions of trauma counseling to help clients process their abuse, develop coping strategies, and move forward in their lives.

Daya staff created 1149 safety plans with clients to address danger while living in or fleeing from unsafe homes.

languages

In 2023, services were provided in 13 languages: English, Arabic, Bengali, Dari, Farsi, Gujarati, Hindi, Malayalam, Pashto, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu.

**301**  
clients received legal services

Daya funded 342 months of rental assistance for clients and their children, allowing them to establish new, abuse-free lives.

52 clients and their children were safely housed through rental assistance, utility payments, and follow up services related to employment, continuing education, and childcare

Daya assisted 301 clients in immigration and family courts through attorney consultations, information on their rights, and court accompaniment.
